### Description

This Invitation for Bid (IFB) is a solicitation to supply the following goods or services to Milwaukee County:

**Bridge Replacement (including removal and disposition of existing bridge) Franklin Park  
Ryan Creek**

Milwaukee County Parks is interested in replacing the existing wooden snowmobile bridge and replacing it with a new bridge located in Franklin Park. The project has limited access and will utilize an asphalt driveway on private property and farm fields to reach the project site. Access to the site is limited to only light to medium size trucks, all-terrain vehicles (ATV's), light construction equipment (such as: mini-excavators, bobcats, skid steers) are permitted on the site access/route driveway. No heavy trucks, concrete trucks, dump trucks, and semi-trucks are permitted.

The proposed bridge shall be prefabricated steel beams and wood deck in sections, delivered and assembled on site. The new bridge shall be designed for 25,000 pound live load and meet WDNR guidelines and requirements for an ATV and snowmobile bridge. The main bridge span shall be 12 feet wide x 30 feet long with a 12 foot wide x 15 foot long approach at each end. Bridge submittals shall include complete and comprehensive stamped design computations from an experienced professional engineer licensed in the State of Wisconsin.
