Attached is Attachment L the footings for Block 22.

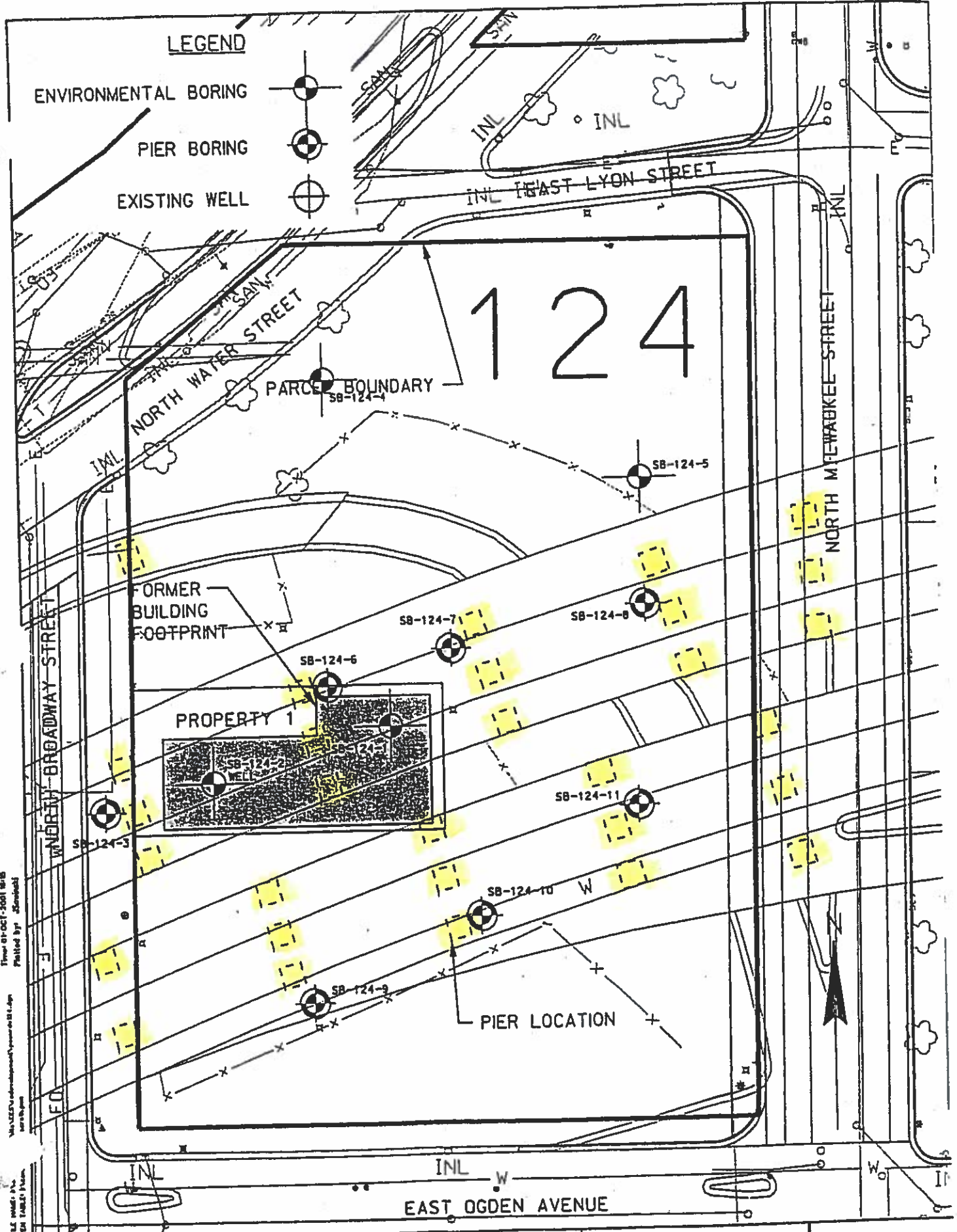
