To Whom It May Concern:

Please be advised Milwaukee County is permissibly self-insured.

Milwaukee County is a municipal body corporate that self-funds for liability under §893.80 and 895.46(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and automobile liability under Statute §345.05. Milwaukee County is also permissibly self-insured under Wisconsin Statute §102.28(2)(bm) for Workers' Compensation. The protection is applicable to officers, employees, and agents while acting within the scope of their employment or agency.

Retentions and other costs of risk, including our contractual obligations, are financed under appropriation and fund accounting principles applicable to government operations. As a tax-levying public body with statutory bonding authority, a government has financial resources not available to private insurers who may lack the financial capacity of a government and can be dissolved.

Please accept this as proof of Milwaukee County's financial responsibility.
