MILWAUKEE – The 2022 General Election takes place tomorrow, Tuesday, November 8. Supervisor Sequanna Taylor issued the following statement encouraging increased participation in District 5.

Races reported by Milwaukee County include the elections for: Governor/Lieutenant Governor, U.S. Senator, State Treasurer, Attorney General, Secretary of State, Representatives in Congress – Districts 1, 4, and 5, State Senators – Districts 3, 5, and 7, Representatives to the Assembly – Districts 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 23, 82, and 84, Milwaukee County Sheriff, Milwaukee County Clerk of Circuit Court, Special Election for City of Milwaukee, Aldermanic Districts 2 and 3 and multiple county, municipal, and school board referendum questions.

The Milwaukee County Election Commission will report the results of the 2022 General Election in real time on Tuesday, November 8 in the cafeteria of the Milwaukee County Courthouse.
