The ribbon-cutting ceremony will take place on **Friday, June 13, 2025**, at 10:30 a.m. at the Center's new home: 1230 W Cherry Street, in Milwaukee's King Park Neighborhood. A community celebration, building tours, and a resource fair will follow from 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

My family and I are deeply honored to share in this moment and reflect on my grandmother's legacy of service. This Center stands as a testament to her visionary spirit and unwavering dedication to justice."*

Supervisor Coggs-Jones extended deep gratitude to her colleagues on the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for their vision and unwavering support of this transformative project.

The ceremony will feature remarks from Supervisor Coggs-Jones and other dignitaries, along with a special tribute to her grandmother, the late Marcia P. Coggs, a civil rights icon and the first Black woman elected to the Wisconsin State Legislature.

The grand opening will also highlight the Center's new solar-power system, a fitting tribute to Marcia P. Coggs' forward-thinking approach to community sustainability and equity.
