Greendale Garden Walk to Return This Saturday

GREENDALE - The Greendale Garden Walk will return this Saturday, July 13, from 8:00 a.m. to noon, starting at Gazebo Park, 6500 Northway, Greendale, WI 53129. Known as "The Garden Community," Greendale is rooted in the vision of its architects, inspired by English garden communities.

"I am thrilled to invite residents to experience the joy and beauty of our garden community this Saturday. This event is a wonderful opportunity for neighbors and visitors to come together, enjoy the outdoors, and celebrate Greendale's charm," said Supervisor Kathleen Vincent.

The event will feature a gift basket raffle, live music, and refreshments. Participants will begin the free walking tour at Gazebo Park, strolling through the Greendale Original Houses in the "C Section." Along the way, they will meet master gardeners and discover Greendale's unique home gardens.

One of tour's highlights will be the Greendale Children's Garden, which showcases the community's dedication to cultivating a love for nature and gardening in the next generation. Recently, the Greendale Public Health Department and the Village of Greendale were awarded a Livable Communities grant from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services. This grant will significantly enhance the initiatives of the Greendale Children's Garden, making it a more inclusive and engaging space for all community members.

The grant will also support increased community collaboration and partnerships, including the Greendale Park and Recreation Summer Adventure Club. Children involved in the club will spend time in the garden weeding, harvesting, cleaning, and packaging produce. This fresh produce will then be delivered to older adults at the local Senior Social Club, promoting intergenerational connections and ensuring access to nutritious food for senior community members.

The Saturday Greendale Downtown Market along Broad Street, which also takes place from 8:00 a.m. to noon, will feature nearly all its seasonal vendors as a special addition for the Garden Walk.
