Supervisor Vincent to Address Dangerous Dog Concerns at Tuesday's Village of Greendale Board Meeting

GREENDALE — Milwaukee County Supervisor Kathleen Vincent will attend the Village of Greendale's Regular Meeting on Tuesday, September 3, 2024, at 6:00 PM in the Village Hall Board Room, located at 6500 Northway. She plans to join several concerned Greendale residents to address the Village Board regarding ongoing issues with a local family harboring dangerous dogs.

Supervisor Vincent issued the following statement ahead of the meeting:

"I will be joining Greendale residents on Tuesday night to address the Village Board concerning a family in our community that harbors dangerous dogs. These animals have a documented history of aggressive behavior, which has created fear and safety concerns among neighbors. A recent incident, where a dog got loose and attempted to attack another pet, has only heightened the community's anxiety. The neighbor was forced to fight off the dog and sustained injuries from falling over during the altercation. This attempted attack is just the latest example of why action is urgently needed. My mother lives next door to this family and is forced to take extra precautions daily due to the threatening behavior of these dogs.

Several residents will also be present to share their experiences during the citizen comments portion of the meeting, seeking a resolution to this ongoing issue. It's only a matter of time before someone or their pet is seriously injured. I aim to collaborate with Milwaukee County's research team to explore possible resolutions at the County level, given that the Village of Greendale currently seems limited in its ability to act."

Supervisor Vincent encourages all concerned residents to attend Tuesday's meeting and voice their opinions during the citizen comments portion.
