## Milwaukee County Denim Day Photo Opportunity

MILWAUKEE - Milwaukee County will again stand in solidarity with survivors of sexual assault and take a visible stand against sexual violence on Denim Day. County Board Supervisor Sky Z. Capriolo invites all County Supervisors, department heads, and staff to wear denim and join a group photo immediately following the Board of Supervisors meeting on Monday, April 20, 2026. The photo is expected to be taken at approximately 3:15 p.m. in the Rotunda of the Milwaukee County Courthouse (901 N 9th Street). This event is intended to raise awareness by amplifying the Denim Day message: no one should ever be blamed for their assault.

Denim Day is observed globally on the last Wednesday of April to confront harmful myths about sexual assault and show support for survivors. In 2024, the Milwaukee County Board unanimously adopted a [resolution](#), authored by Supervisor Sky Z. Capriolo, with support from Chairwoman Marcelia Nicholson and Supervisor Felesia A. Martin, recognizing Denim Day. Last year, Supervisors and staff wore denim at a Board meeting, took a group photo, and participated in events publicly supporting survivors.

**WHAT:** Group photo in support of Denim Day 2026, an international campaign to raise awareness about sexual violence and support survivors.
