**SUPERVISORS CULLEN, WEDDLE TO HOLD JOINT TOWN HALL MEETING**  
**October 27 Meeting Designed to Get Constituent Input on 2016 Proposed Budget**

Milwaukee County Supervisors Eddie Cullen and Martin Weddle will hold a joint town hall meeting from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 27 at the Washington Park Senior Center, 4420 W. Vliet St. in Milwaukee.

The joint town hall meeting is designed to provide the supervisors with constituent input on the Proposed 2016 Budget as well as other issues affecting residents of the 5<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> districts.

The 5<sup>th</sup> District is roughly bordered by the Historic Third Ward, west to Highway 41, south along Wisconsin Avenue and I-94 and north to Townsend Street. The 15<sup>th</sup> District is roughly bordered by Highway 41 on the east, Cleveland Avenue on the south, and north to 124<sup>th</sup> and Hampton Avenue.

“As a new supervisor I have walked throughout the district to get to know my constituents,” Cullen said. “I want to hear from residents of the 15<sup>th</sup> District to determine their needs in the 2016 budget.”

Weddle said the budget is the most important document passed by the County Board.

“The budget is a set of priorities for the County going into next year,” Weddle said. “It is important that residents of the 5<sup>th</sup> District get to speak out on the issues they believe are important and discuss the budget in a public forum.”

The County Board’s Finance, Personnel and Audit Committee will review the proposed budget over the next few weeks. A public hearing on the budget will be held at the Mitchell Park Conservatory (the Domes) on November 2. The County Board will consider passage of the budget on November 9.
