Supervisor Anthony “Tony” Staskunas Announces Decision Not to Seek Re-Election for the 16th District

MILWAUKEE – Supervisor Anthony “Tony” Staskunas of the 16th District has announced today that he will not seek re-election following the end of his current term. Supervisor Staskunas made the following statement:

“It has been an absolute privilege to serve the residents of Milwaukee County, first in District 17 and now in District 16. After careful consideration and discussions with my family, I have decided that the time has come for me to step aside and let new leadership emerge,” said Supervisor Staskunas. *“I believe in the potential of our district and hope that by announcing my decision early, we will see several high-quality candidates come forward to continue the important work of this office.”*

Supervisor Staskunas was first elected to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors on April 2, 2013. His extensive career includes serving in the Wisconsin State Assembly and as West Allis Alderman. He has also been deeply involved in local community organizations, highlighting his dedication to Milwaukee County beyond his elected positions.

In closing his announcement, Staskunas added:

“I am deeply grateful for the trust and support the residents have shown me throughout my tenure. While I may be stepping away from the County Board, I will always remain a staunch advocate for our community.”

The election for 16th District Milwaukee County Supervisor will be on the ballot for the Spring Election on Tuesday, April 2, 2024. The Spring Primary Election would take place on Tuesday, February 20, 2024, if necessary.
