Chairwoman Nicholson, Mayor Johnson, State Senator Johnson to Tour Milwaukee Institutions, Discuss Stronger Collaboration Friday

MILWAUKEE – County Board Chairwoman Marcelia Nicholson will host Milwaukee Mayor Cavalier Johnson and State Senator LaTonya Johnson for a tour of Milwaukee institutions, to discuss how the county, city, and state can better collaborate to meet the needs of residents, and connect on local option funding sources on Friday, June 24.

The tour will begin at 10 a.m. at Miss Katie’s Diner, a local establishment that has been open since 1985 and was a recipient of a [Milwaukee County Small Business Initiative Grant](#) in 2021.

The officials will travel to Washington Park (arriving approximately 10:45 a.m.), where they will receive a tour of the grounds and learn more about plans for the new Urban Ecology Center facility at the park as well as the ongoing collaboration between Milwaukee County and local partners that made the investment possible.

From there, they will walk across the street to the Washington Park Library (arriving approximately 11:45 a.m.), where they will receive a tour of the facility from Library Director Joan Johnson and discuss how the State of Wisconsin can work with municipalities to expand services for residents.

Media are invited to join for the entire tour or a preferred portion. Chairwoman Nicholson, Mayor Johnson and Senator Johnson will be available for interviews at the sites.
