County Board of Supervisors;

The Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) informed the Milwaukee Brewers organization that it will not be providing transit services directly into the American Family Field parking lot in 2022. Baseball games will continue to be served by MCTS GoldLine, and Route 18, both of which have stops within walking distance of the ballpark.

As we continue to focus on recruitment and retention to stabilize workforce issues, MCTS is acknowledging that service to the ballpark would compete for resources dedicated to ensuring reliable transit for our every-day passengers. Furthermore, a report was presented to the Finance Committee last month (File #22-457) that projected a significant fiscal gap for transit in less than three years. *By FY2025, federal stimulus funding provided to the transit system is fully depleted and no longer available to offset transit services. Absent any additional funding sources before FY2025, the result is an estimated increase of \$32.9 million in the County's cost-to-continue in FY2025.*

Discontinuation of the Brewers Line service is a step towards closing the pending fiscal gap. As you are already aware, MCTS will not be providing service directly to Summerfest in 2022 either. Service direct to ethnic festivals and direct to State Fair also fall into the category of services not planned to be operated. A report is being prepared for the May Committee cycle to provide more information on this subject. In the meantime, if you have any questions, please let me know. Thank you.
