County Election Commission to Certify Results of 2021 Spring Election Thursday

Recount request possible in District 10 County Board Supervisor race

Milwaukee - The Milwaukee County Board of Election Commissioners will [meet](#) as the Board of Canvassers to certify the results of the April 6 Spring Election on Thursday at 9 a.m.

Once the election is certified, the Milwaukee County Board Supervisor – District 10 race will qualify for a recount. There is no automatic recount under Wisconsin law, but in a race where fewer than 4,000 votes are cast, a candidate may request a recount if their vote total is within 40 votes of the winner's total. The unofficial results reported on election night indicated a difference of 12 votes.

The earliest a candidate could file a petition for a recount is immediately following the certification of the results. The deadline for filing a recount petition is 5 p.m. on the third business day after the last meeting day of the board of canvassers, or Tuesday, April 20 at 5 p.m.

A potential recount would start no earlier than 9 a.m. on Monday, April 19 and the latest any potential recount would commence is 9 a.m. on Wednesday, April 21.

If there is a recount in the District 10 election, officials estimate that recounting those ballots should take approximately five hours to complete.
