## **Clerk Christenson Encourages Voters to Thank Election Workers**

MILWAUKEE – Milwaukee County Clerk George Christenson made the following statement reminding voters of the vital role played by hundreds of dedicated election officials throughout Milwaukee County:

Clerk Christenson went on to commend Governor Tony Evers for his recent action in signing bipartisan legislation aimed at enhancing the safety and security of election officials across Wisconsin stating:

*“Election safety is a paramount concern, and I applaud Governor Evers for taking decisive action to protect the dedicated individuals who work tirelessly to uphold the integrity of our electoral process. These measures are vital for preserving the sanctity of our elections and maintaining public trust in our democratic institutions. Election officials play a pivotal role in our democracy, often laboring long hours under demanding conditions to ensure the fairness and transparency of our elections. When you’re at the polls today, please take a moment to thank our dedicated election workers for their invaluable service.”*

The referenced signed legislation includes provisions to strengthen protections for election officials, exempting their personal identifying information from public records requests, provides whistleblower protections for reporting election fraud or irregularities, and establishes a new felony crime for battery against an election official.
