**RE:** **SHARING OF THE DIVISION OF MILWAUKEE CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES (DMCPS) RECORDS WITH THE GUARDIAN AD LITEM (GAL) AND CHILDREN'S DIVISION COURT LEGAL COUNSEL FOR PURPOSES OF SCREENING CHAPTER 54 GUARDIANSHIPS**

**EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 3, 2019:**

**IT IS HEREBY DIRECTED** that, the Court authorizes the DMCPS to share abuse and neglect reports and records under Wis. Stat. §48.78(2) (a) relating to the child who may be the subject of a Chapter 54 guardianship; and,


**IT IS HEREBY DIRECTED** that, the Court authorizes the guardian ad litem to access any Chapter 48 court files, under Wis. Stat. §48.396(2), relating to the child who may be the subject of a Chapter 54 guardianship; and,

**IT IS HEREBY DIRECTED** that, information related to the child's parents, and any prospective guardian shall be shared with the assigned GAL for the purpose of investigating the guardianship request and making a recommendation to the court regarding the appropriateness of the request; and,

**IT IS HEREBY DIRECTED** that, information related to the child's parents, and any prospective guardian shall be shared with the Children's Division court staff for the purpose of screening the request for appropriateness, legal sufficiency, and any potential issues related to the filing of the petition; now therefore,

**IT IS HEREBY FURTHER DIRECTED** that, the GAL and Children's Division Court Legal Counsel that obtains access to a report or record from DMCPs, shall keep the information confidential and may only disclose that information to the court, unless directed by the court to disclose that information to all parties to the proceeding.
