Purpose of Form: The proposed guardian completes and submits this statement to the court at least 96 hours before the initial hearing on the petition for guardianship.

Who Completes It: Proposed guardian.

Distribution of Form: Court; copies to the child – if 12 years or older, child’s parents, child’s Guardian, child’s Legal Custodian, child’s *Guardian ad Litem*/Adversary Counsel, Tribe (if any), Indian Custodian (if any), and Additional Interested Persons (if any).
