## **CIVIL & FAMILY DIVISIONS**

Civil Division Courts manage large claims, small claims, family, paternity, replevins, evictions, garnishments and other civil actions. In addition, they process appeals from various governmental commissions and from Municipal Courts throughout Milwaukee County.

The Clerk of Circuit Court staff assigned to the Civil Division consult with litigants and attorneys on procedural matters; assigns all civil and family cases; collects civil and family filing fees; calculates costs; enters and docket judgments, liens and satisfactions. The Civil Division administrative staff directs the work of the courts' staff. The Clerk of Circuit Court prepares and maintains automated court records through the Consolidated Court Automation Programs (CCAP). The Civil Division of the Clerk of Circuit Court also provides electronic filing consistent with state statutes. The division is responsible for maintaining the court files and electronic records for all civil and family matters.

Family Division Courts hear default and contested cases on all matters relative to actions set forth in Chapter 767 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

## **CRIMINAL DIVISION**

The courts in the Criminal Division hear, try and determine all matters for pretrial, trial and post-conviction proceedings in felony, misdemeanor and traffic matters. In addition, the Misdemeanor Courts conduct proceedings on matters in which jury demands have been filed in Milwaukee County municipal courts.

The Clerk of Circuit Court staff assigned to the Criminal Division consults with litigants, attorneys, law enforcement agencies and the Department of Corrections on procedural matters; processes the records and orders of the courts; receives cases from the various municipal courts; accepts payments for fines and fees, and accounts for and disburses payments to the County Treasurer; prepares Judgments of Conviction and other necessary documents for court actions; accepts document filings for cases; processes Return of Property petitions; accepts and processes applications for occupational licenses; processes criminal case appeals; conducts Milwaukee County criminal case searches; prepares and maintains court records through the Consolidated Court Automation Programs (CCAP) and maintains the court files and/or records for all criminal matters.

## **CHILDREN'S DIVISION**

Children's Court exercises jurisdiction over delinquency cases for juveniles under the age of 17, child abuse and neglect cases for children up to age 18 (or 21 in certain circumstance), guardianships of minor persons, termination of parental rights, adoptions, child abuse and harassment injunctions involving minors, and ordinance violations.

The Clerk of Circuit Court staff assigned to the Children's Division prepares statutorily required legal documents, enters court records into the docket; processes court orders; reviews professional service vouchers; processes witness fees, victim/witness surcharges and restitution; processes appeals of Children's Court cases to the 1<sup>st</sup> District of the Wisconsin Court of Appeals; prepares and maintains court records through the Consolidated Court Automation Programs (CCAP) and maintains the physical and electronic court files and documents.

The Clerk of Circuit Court, Children's Division also handles on-site jury trials for Children in need of Protection and Services and/or Termination of Parental Rights cases.

The Probate Division provides the Circuit Courts, attorneys and members of the general public with courteous, professional and proficient services that facilitate proceedings for the administration of decedent's estates, testamentary trusts, guardianships, protective placements, civil mental health commitments, adult adoptions and other related proceedings within the Circuit Courts and/or the Register in Probate office.

The Clerk of Circuit Court/Register in Probate staff assigned to the Probate Division maintains a record, in full, of all Wills/Codicils admitted to probate and those filed for safekeeping; reviews and approves professional service vouchers; makes court record entries; processes appeals to the 1<sup>st</sup> District of Wisconsin Court of Appeals; and collects statutorily required fees. The Clerk of Circuit Court/Register in Probate staff prepares and maintains court records through the Consolidated Court Automation Programs (CCAP) and maintains court files for all probate matters.

## **JURY MANAGEMENT DIVISION**

The Jury Management Division is responsible for providing the Circuit Courts of Milwaukee County with sufficient jurors for conducting jury trials in the Civil, Family, Criminal and Children's courts. The Consolidated Court Automation Programs (CCAP) maintains a list of eligible jurors randomly selected from the State of Wisconsin, Department of Transportation Database. Jurors are summoned from this list.

The Clerk of Circuit Court staff assigned to the Jury Management Division prepares all information regarding juror eligibility and executes the necessary administrative steps to ensure attendance of sufficient jurors for the daily needs of the courts. The Jury Division maintains attendance and payroll records for the jurors called; answers inquiries relating to jury service from the public and from persons who have been selected to serve as jurors.
