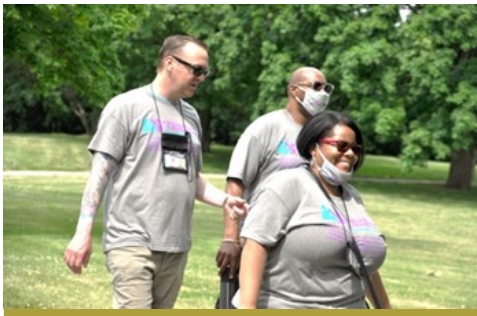




# WORLD ELDER ABUSE AWARENESS DAY
