**D**emographics

*Age, sex, blood thinners?*

**M**echanism

*Type – GSW, stab wound, MVC, fall*

**I**njuries

*List significant injuries head to toe*

**S**everity / Signs

*GCS, vitals, patient complaints*

**T**reatments

*Interventions, medications, fluids,  
patient response*

**Goals:**

- Improve passage of information
- Decrease missed critical information
- Reduce unnecessary radio traffic
- Increase direct patient care time for all providers
- Decrease verbal hand off times
