## Oral Anticoagulants and Antiplatelets



Oral anticoagulation pharmacotherapy is used to control and prevent thromboembolic disorders. The goal is to avoid hemorrhagic complications but achieve sufficient suppression of thrombosis.

Oral antiplatelet pharmacotherapy reduces the risk of heart attack or stroke by preventing blood cells from sticking together to form clots.
