## Milwaukee County DHHS Aging & Disability Services

Transportation – Your Connection to Community

Transportation connects us to our community and helps us to live healthy, active and fulfilling lives. Without transportation, it is difficult to stay connected to friends and loved ones, remain involved with hobbies and wellness activities, and meet our daily needs, like going grocery shopping and getting to medical appointments. While we may be accustomed to driving ourselves around to all of our daily destinations, it's important to know that other transportation options exist.

In Milwaukee County, there are a variety of transportation options that get older adults and people with disabilities to the places they need to go. Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) operates a bus system with fare options like GoPass and Reduced Fare Card for qualifying riders. MCTS also operates Transit Plus, a county-wide paratransit service for those that are unable to ride the buses. Milwaukee County also has a volunteer driver program provided through ERAS Senior Network.

Lastly, Milwaukee County Aging and Disabilities Services provides Older Adult Transportation Service (OATS), which connects eligible older adults to healthcare appointments, grocery shopping, senior centers, wellness programs, voting, and more.
