

*Milwaukee County Personnel Review Board*

Mr. Kern moved, Mr. Renz seconded, and the Board by unanimous vote (4-0) that, based on the facts and circumstances of this case, the Board shall hold an order of discharge in abeyance. CO Austin will serve an unpaid, time-served suspension. Additionally, pursuant to Rule VI, Section 9 of the Board's Rules of Procedure, the

Board imposes a re-evaluation period for the remainder of CO Austin's employment with Milwaukee County. The re-evaluation period is to be served by CO Austin upon his return to work following satisfactory completion of an alcohol screening test.
