UPDATE REGARDING SHOTS FIRED INCIDENT FROM 02/03/2019: SUSPECT APPREHENDED AFTER BRIEF PURSUIT

March 5, 2019

MILWAUKEE, WI - On Monday, March 4, 2019, at 7:13 a.m., members of the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office and the United States Marshal's Fugitive Task Force apprehended a suspect in a February 3, 2019 incident in which shots were fired into the 2200 block of N. 47th St.

Deputies attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the suspect at the intersection of E. Howard Avenue and S. Lake Drive in St. Francis. During the attempted traffic stop, the suspect struck the rear of an unmarked squad car and fled the scene. Deputies pursued the suspect for a short distance before the suspect stopped and surrendered in a parking lot in the 4200 block of S. Lake Drive. Neither the suspect nor officers reported any injuries.

The following charges will be presented to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for review:

- 1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety, Class F Felony, up to 12 ½ years in prison if convicted
- Fleeing / Eluding, Class I Felony, up to 3 ½ years in prison if convicted
