Milwaukee County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) is hereby requesting your firm's Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) for providing construction management services for the above referenced construction project in the Village of Brown Deer, Milwaukee County.

An interview will not be scheduled to further assess your firm's qualifications. **Milwaukee County reserves the right to enter into immediate negotiations and contract award with any short-listed firm based solely on the information contained in the SOQ.** If negotiations result in an award of a contract to the selected firm, then all remaining firms will be notified accordingly. If negotiations with the selected firm fail to result in a contract award, then negotiations will begin with the next firm selected and so on.

The current DBE program has been suspended by the U.S. Department of Transportation pursuant to interim final rule (FR Document 2025-19426, 90 FR 48116-48117). No DBE program requirements will be applied.
