RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT | JANUARY 2026



W. RAWSON AVENUE (CTH BB) WINTER SHUTDOWN

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), in partnership with Milwaukee County, is reconstructing W. Rawson Avenue (CTH BB) from S. 13th Street to S. Howell Avenue. The project began in spring 2025 and is scheduled to continue through late fall 2025, with restoration and remaining work to be completed in spring 2026.

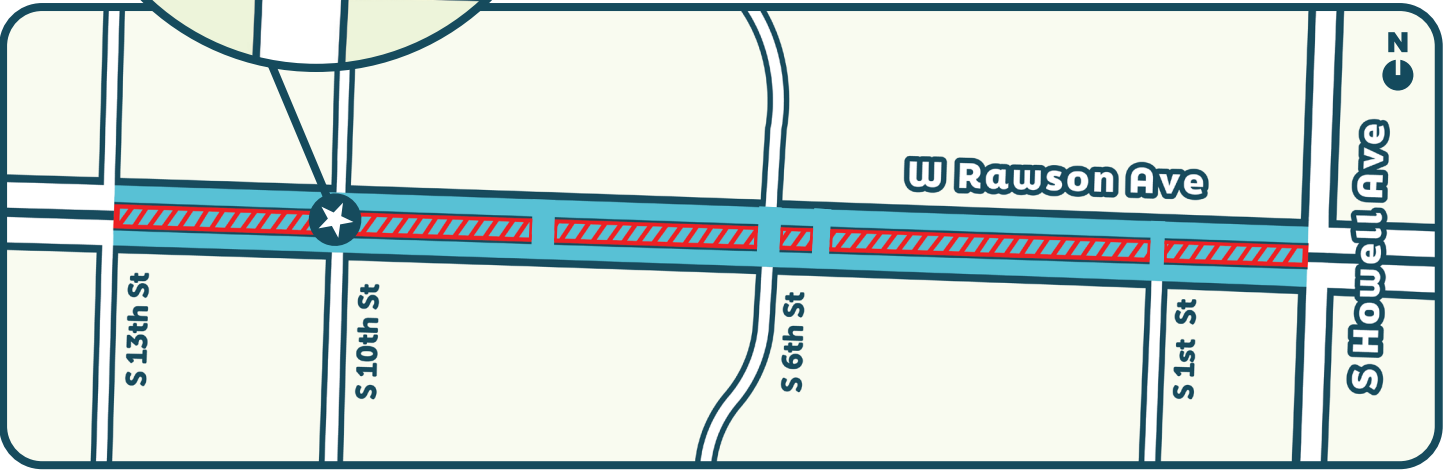
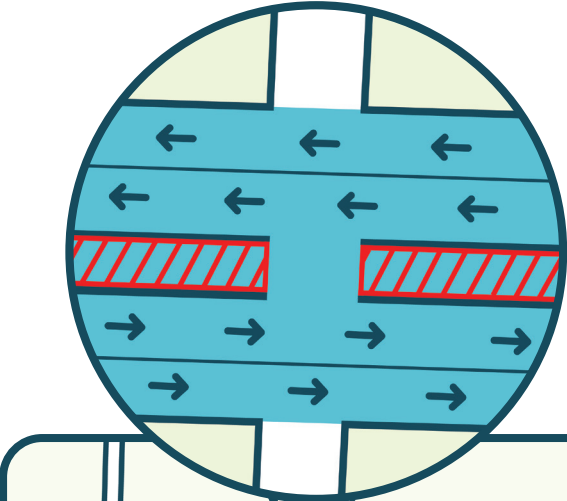
JANUARY 9, 2026:

S. 10th Street at the intersection of Rawson Avenue (CTH BB) is scheduled to fully reopen by January 9.

The traffic pattern will remain in place until work resumes in spring 2026.

During the winter shutdown:

- Rawson Avenue (CTH BB), from S. 13th Street to S. Howell Avenue, will reopen to two lanes in each direction for the duration of the shutdown.
- S. 6th Street at the intersection of Rawson Avenue (CTH BB) has shifted to its respective sides and fully opened to traffic.
