

Project Location



Purpose and Need

- Pavement deterioration
 - Cracking and rutting due to poor underlying soils
 - The pavement is nearing the end of its service life
- Bridge deterioration
 - Lannon stone fascia is deteriorating/missing stones
 - Cracking along concrete arch
 - Spalling concrete
 - Railing is rusting

Proposed Improvements

- Pavement improvements are recommended to keep traffic moving safely and efficiently
 - Replace asphaltic pavement
 - Replace concrete curb and gutter
 - Replace asphaltic sidewalk with concrete sidewalk
 - Repairs to inlets and storm sewer

Proposed Improvements

- Bridge Repairs are recommended to keep traffic moving safely and efficiently
 - Concrete surface repairs
 - Epoxy injection of cracks in concrete arch
 - Replace deteriorated lannon stones on fascia and retaining wall
 - Repaint the metal railing



Current Construction Schedule

- Construction is anticipated in 2022
- Construction is expected to take two to three months (weather permitting)
 - Actual months of work will be determined by the contractor
 - There are time restrictions for work within Oak Creek

Proposed Construction Staging

- Maintaining safety and mobility during construction are high priorities
 - Road closed with posted detour route
- Proposed detour route for vehicles and bicycles
 - Hawthorne Avenue to N. Chicago Avenue to Milwaukee Avenue
 - Restricts truck traffic on Oak Creek Parkway

Current Project Schedule

- Concept plans – April 2020
- Local officials meeting – May 2020
- Public involvement meeting – June 2020
- Final environmental documents – Summer 2020
- Preliminary plans – Fall 2020
- Final plans – August 2021
- Construction – 2022


