Milwaukee County Department of Transportation (MCDOT), Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) and their design consultant, Kapur and Associates, are holding a Public Involvement Meeting for the proposed improvements at the S. 76th St. (CTH U) Bridge over Forest Home Avenue (STH 24) in the City of Greenfield.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday, October 18, 2023, from 4:30 pm to 6:30 pm in the Council Chambers at Greenfield City Hall, located at 7325 W. Forest Home Ave., Greenfield, Wisconsin 53220. The meeting will be an "Open House" format and no formal presentation will be made. Project related sketches and plans will be displayed at the meeting. Representatives from Milwaukee County and Kapur & Associates will be available to answer questions.

The purpose of the meeting is to provide information on the proposed improvements, to obtain input that will assist the department in further development and refinement of the project, and to provide the public involvement documents for your review. A project overview and comment sheet are enclosed.

The S. 76th Street bridge improvements are being proposed to address bridge deteriorations. Rehabilitation work will include bridge deck overlay, abutment repair, railing repair, and sidewalk repair. All existing pedestrian ramps will be evaluated, and if needed, improved to current ADA standards.

The roadway will be open to traffic with one lane in each direction during construction. Construction of the project is scheduled for 2025.

Persons with an interest in or knowledge about historical and archaeological resources in the project area, are invited to present such information at the meeting.
