Milwaukee County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) is holding a Virtual Public Involvement Meeting for the proposed reconditioning of W. Beloit Road (CTH T) S. 124th Street to S. Wollmer Road.

As a precaution against COVID-19, MCDOT is changing the format of the Public Involvement Meeting. Rather than meeting in person, we are providing project information in this letter and are requesting public input via mail, email, or phone. The purpose of the meeting is to provide information on the proposed roadway improvements and obtain property owner input to assist us in further developing the project. A project overview, informational handout and a comment sheet are enclosed.

The proposed project will recondition W. Beloit Road (CTH T). W. Beloit Road (CTH T) will remain a 4-lane rural roadway from S. 124th Street to approximately 450 feet west of S. 108th Street (WIS 100). Approximately 500 feet of W. Beloit Road (CTH T) to the east of S. 108th Street (WIS 100) will be reconstructed as an 8-lane divided urban roadway with curb and gutter.

On-street bicycle accommodations are proposed throughout the length of the project. A new shared-use path or sidewalk is proposed on the south side of W. Beloit Road (CTH T) from the Oak Leaf Trail crossing to S. 108th Street (WIS 100). New sidewalk is proposed along both sides of W. Beloit Road (CTH T) east of S. 108th Street (WIS 100) to the east project limits, wherever it doesn't already exist.

The project proposes to add or lengthen turn lanes at multiple intersections and to replace the traffic signals at the S. 124th Street and S. 112th Street/W. Howard Avenue intersections. The proposed pavement surface is asphalt from S. 124th Street to S. 108th Street (WIS 100) and concrete east of S. 108th Street (WIS 100). Some storm sewer upgrades will be made to improve drainage along the project corridor. No water main or sanitary sewer construction is anticipated at this time. Construction is anticipated to begin in the Spring of 2022 and is estimated to be completed in the Fall of 2022.

The following are commonly asked questions and answers about roadway reconditioning and reconstruction projects:

- **Will I be able to get to my property during construction?**
Yes. Access to properties will be maintained at all times through construction staging and traffic control. Staging and traffic control scenarios are currently being evaluated for the project.
- **Will I be assessed for the new sidewalk adjacent to my property or for any of the work involved with the project?**
No. Milwaukee County does NOT assess property owners for the roadway improvements (including the addition of the sidewalks).
- **Who is responsible for maintaining (i.e. clearing snow) the new sidewalk adjacent to my property?**
The City of Greenfield will own the new sidewalk and maintenance responsibilities will fall under their jurisdiction. Contact the City of Greenfield for further information.
- **Will basic services like mail delivery and garbage pickup continue during construction?**
Yes. Access to properties will be maintained for services like garbage pickup. Mail delivery/pickup will be moved to a designated location nearby during construction and continue uninterrupted.
- **Who do I contact if I have a question or issue during construction?**
There will be a full-time construction engineer on site to answer any questions or assist with issues regarding the project. The project engineer may also be contacted (see below).
