Subject: **Request for Statement of Qualification (SOQ)
Roadway Design Engineering Services**

Consultants are invited to submit a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) to provide professional engineering design services for the following roadway project in Milwaukee County:

Recondition of W Beloit Rd (CTH T) Roadway from S 108th St to W Oklahoma Ave in the City of Greenfield; County Design Project No. WH0263011/State Design Project No. 2525-05-01; anticipated 2030 construction.

The design will be funded under the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Surface Transportation Program (STP) and must adhere to federal and state standards, including the WisDOT Facilities Development Manual (FDM), the WisDOT Bridge Manual, and the Local Public Agency (LPA) Manual. Additionally, design must comply with National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) environmental regulations, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, Buy America, and WisDOT standard specifications.

The SOQ intends to provide the reviewer information about your firm's interest, understanding, availability, and ability to deliver design support as needed for the referenced project. The SOQ should be limited to ten (10) pages per project of interest. It should include a description of your company's expertise and qualifications, statement of interest, description of the project team, project understanding, availability, delivery, and a list of most recent related project experiences. Project team members' credential/resume must be attached as an appendix.

It is required that the SOQ clearly reflects your understanding of the project scope, its location and present condition. It is required that you visit the project site(s) in advance of preparing the SOQ. The SOQ shall identify all sub-consultants.

This project has a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal that is 0%. The current federal DBE program has been suspended by the U.S. Department of Transportation pursuant to interim final rule (FR Document 2025-19426, 90 FR 48116-48117). Accordingly, for federally funded proposals, no federal DBE program requirements will be applied.

One (1) email copy of the SOQ shall be received no later than 2:00 p.m. on **May 15, 2026**, and addressed as follows:

SOQ by joint venture groups, as well as individual companies will be considered. Companies will be shortlisted, and one consultant company would be selected. If interviews are necessary, the short-listed companies would be contacted accordingly. The SOQ becomes the property of Milwaukee County upon its submittal. Milwaukee County reserves the right to enter into immediate negotiations and contract award with any short-listed firm based solely on the information contained in the SOQ. If negotiations result in an award of contract to the selected firm, then all remaining firms will be notified accordingly. If negotiations with the selected firm fail to result in a contract award, then negotiations will begin with the next firm selected and so on.
